Program Notes:

The Medical Asst. program is a Fall start program with sequenced coursework. MDAS 101 and MDAS102 are only offered in Fall. MDAS105 is only offered in Spring, MDAS201 is only offered in Summer.

After completing the Medical Assistant program, students can take the Registered Medical Assistant -American Medical Technologist (RMA_AMT) Certification Exam.

Students can continue their education at NCC by pursuing the Health Care Office Specialist (Certificate-44cr) or the Health Care Office Coordinator, AAS (Associate-62cr). All courses in the MA program will transfer into both programs.

Additional Requirements:

After applying to the program, students are required to submit the following:

- Background Clearances (PA State Police, FBI, Child Abuse)
- Health Insurance
- Physical Examination
- Immunizations
- Titers
- COVID-19 and Flu Vaccinations
- Urine Drug Screen
- BLS for Healthcare Providers (CPR) Certification

It is the student's responsibility to be knowledgeable of NCC graduation requirements and, if applicable, to verify transfer requirements with the 4-year institution. Courses listed on the program map are based upon the assumption that prerequisites and courses taken in previous semesters will be successfully completed.
